Greetings to the members and friends of the Notre Dame Tabernacle Society

Our Society has been abundantly blessed during the last year from Sept. 1, 2022 through Aug. 31, 2023. Working together, our Hamilton members, and northern group of seamstresses fulfilled 145 requests as we shipped 478 vestments, 6,580 Rosaries, 32 Mass Kits with candles, and innumerable religious articles, holy cards, crosses, prayer booklets, medals, etc. for priests in India, and Ghana, Malawi, Nigeria, South Sudan, Tanzania, and Uganda in Africa. Many of our missionaries are in areas where active persecutions are taking place. Please pray that God will protect them in their ministry.

We did experience the loss of two of our long-time members. Donna Trudel passed into eternal life in March. She oversaw packing boxes and recording the items shipped to our missionaries. Her peaceful presence is greatly missed by all of us. Eileen Pleiman, age 94, died in June. Eileen sewed vestments and made Rosaries for many years with her Meyer sisters in the Osgood and St. Henry area of northern Ohio.

Elaine Fryer, who was our acting president, retired from sewing due to health issues. She continues to use her knitting and crocheting talents to supply items to our yearly raffle.

During the past year, we welcomed additional seamstresses in Hamilton and the group in the St. Henry's area. God answers our prayers for additional talent. Three new Rosary making groups reached out to send us Rosaries in recent months from St. Francis de Sales, Lebanon, OH, St. Jude Parish, Indianapolis, IN, and St. Luke Parish, Palm Springs, FL. We also received religious articles for shipment from as far away as Worthington, OH, Pittsburgh, PA, and Petaluma, CA.

Our Hamilton group prays to Mary, Undoer of Knots, for guidance in locating an alternative weekly meeting space for sewing. We currently use nearly 2,000 square feet of space in the basement of Joan Krabbe's home that was designed for NDTS when the Krabbe's built in 2006. Joan is in her late 80's and concerned about the future of the Society. Contact us if you know of available space.

Without your help we could not carry on this missionary work. In addition to all your prayers and financial support, we received continuing assistance from the following sources:
